

GRANT TOWNSHIP ELECTRICAL PERMIT APPLICATION

Electrical permits must be filled out completely and sign by the applicant (Section V).

Permit fee includes the application fee, service fee, all circuit and fixture fees plus a final inspection fee. If you have any questions while filling out the permit contact Dave Rutkofske at 810 327-6181. **When completed mail permit application along with your check or money order made out to Grant Township to Dave Rutkofske, 6171 Hewitt Rd, Grant Township, Michigan, 48032.**

Construction projects of 3,500 square feet with services 400 amps and above must be submitted for plan review.

Home Owners:

Services are required to have two ground rods at least 6' apart with one continues ground wire between then terminating at the first disconnect. From the first disconnect into the house and there after grounds and neutrals must be kept separate with grounds being terminated on a ground bar in the panel.

All circuits in bedrooms must have Arc Fault protection; this includes plugs, lights and smoke detectors.

Kitchen counter tops as well as any island must have GFCI protection with a minimum of two 20-amp circuits. Plugs in the bathroom, garage, wet bars, crawl spaces and basements are required to have GFCI protection as well.

Smoke detectors are required in all bedrooms plus on each level including basements. Example if you have a second story with three bedrooms you will need 4 detectors upstairs plus one for the main floor, basement and although not required you should consider one in any attached garage. Detectors must be all wired together with 14/3 cable and wired so if one goes off they all go off.

Any penetrations for cables passing between floors or into ceiling cavities must be draft stopped.

Ceiling fans must have a junction box approved for ceiling fan use. It is recommended that you wire the ceiling fan with a 14/3 cable to the switch junction box.

Plans and Specifications must be submitted when the wiring or alteration to an electrical system is over 400 amps and is in excess of 3,500 square feet in all buildings. Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 sq ft in area
2. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00

V. APPLICATION SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the State Construction Code Act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523a, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or structure. Violators of Section 23a are subject to civil fines.

VI. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT

VII. Fee Clarifications

Item #29 Pre-manufactured / Mobile Home Fees

When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus # of park sites.

When settling a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor

When settling a HUD mobile home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.
